# **CDS SIMBAD Privacy Policy**

## **Service description:**

The SIMBAD service provides basic data, cross-identifications, bibliography and measurements for astronomical objects (outside the solar system) published in scientific journals.

#### Personal data:

By default, the web site makes use of cookies to provide better navigation. This is limited to the storage of display preferences. Users are free to set the browser to not accept cookies. The cookies remain as long as the user does not remove them.

Logs are retained and processed for the purposes of error resolution as well as performance evaluation. The information in the logs is transformed as a pseudonymisation, according to the <u>General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)</u> after 2 years.

There are also sub-services where personal data is managed through the <a href="CDS">CDS</a> authentication <a href="System">System</a>:

- Login, first-name, last-name, email, comment (comments can be optionally made public by the user)

The user login is used as a unique identification in the CDS authentication system. The user email address and full name, are stored for the purpose of sending notifications or feedback.

### **Data security**

The SIMBAD websites and services use SSL encryption. The servers are only accessible to the service administrators.
